

DAP Poster Contest 2010-2011

“NOT NOW, NOT EVER”

The purpose of the Elks’ Drug Awareness Poster Contest is to involve children, schools, and parents in the Drug Awareness program, to create opportunities for States to gain national recognition, and generate publicity for local Lodges, State Associations, and the Drug Awareness Program. The posters are used to create the Drug Awareness coloring book.

- The Contest is open to students in grades 3 – 5.
- The poster should be based on the theme “Not Now, Not EVER.”
- The poster should be original, neat, and age-appropriate.
- The poster should be drawn on 8.5” by 11” paper.
- The poster should contain an anti-drug message.
- The poster should not contain characters or items that are trademarked.
- In addition to the poster itself, the following information is needed:
 - Name of the student
 - Age of the student
 - Grade of the student
 - Home address of the student
 - Name of student’s school
 - Location of school and grade
 - Name and number of the sponsoring Elks Lodge
 - Hold harmless agreement
- Posters should be enclosed in a pocket file folder, with completed entry form attached to the outside front cover.

Students should be informed that the posters become the property of the BPOE and will not be returned.

The contest began July 1, 2010, and posters must be in the hands of the State Chairperson by **March 31, 2011**.

Each State winner will receive a \$100.00 Savings bond, and the winning poster for each state will be included in the DAP coloring book.

The National winner will receive a \$500.00 Savings bond, and the National winning poster will be featured on the cover of the DAP coloring book.
